



What is a Viable Business Idea?


A business idea is a succinct and detailed description of the core functions of a planned enterprise. You must be certain of the type of business you want to run before starting one.

Things your Business Idea will Tell




A good business idea will be compatible with the sustainable use of natural resources and will respect the social and natural environment on which it depends.

Which need will your business fulfil for the customers?




What good or service will your business sell?
