Regulatory Enforcement	Strict oversight by the Department of Labour under the Factories Ordinance.	20%
Export & Stakeholder Demand	Pressure from Foreign buyers or local conglomerates	20%
Economic Scale & Impact	Contribution to national GDP and total formal employment volume.	15%
Certification Readiness	Availability of baseline safety culture and commitment for implementation	15%
